Fanfare Energy, LLC (“Fanfare Energy”) is required to report fuel sources and emissions data on a quarterly basis under Section 16-127 of the Electric Service and Customer Choice and Rate Relief of 1997 and the regulations of the Illinois Commerce Commission, 83 Ill. Admin. Code 421. This report reflects that 100% of the total electricity supplied was through the PJM System Mix; the amount of nuclear waste attributable to producing electricity is not known and is not included in the table below. All other emissions are calculated using the PJM System Mix.

This report does not necessarily reflect the actual characteristics of energy that Fanfare Energy will supply.
